Station #1 – Tack

The participants learn all about the purpose of Tack, and participate in cleaning leather used at the farm



Station #2- How a Horse Moves!

Participants learn about the gaits of a horse, and actively participate in learning about their movement!



Station #3: “Poop Station”

Participants learn all about the care a horse requires – what a horse eats, and the work involved in keeping their environment clean.



Station # 4 –Grooming

Participants learn the importance of grooming, and are given a hands-on opportunity to brush a horse.



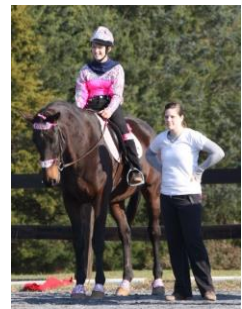
Preparing for your Visit
